Notice of Trust Policies

In recognition of the hardship resulting from the current COVID-19 pandemic, effective August 1, 2020 the Trust adopts the following policies:

The Trust suspends any requirement that a document submitted to the Trust be notarized. Documents may be submitted to the Trust without notarization as provided below.

The Trust suspends any requirement that a document be witnessed by more than one person or by a person unrelated to the signatory. Documents may be witnessed by one person who is a family member.

Provided the claimant's law firm has entered an electronic filer agreement with the Trust and Verus Claims Services, the Trust will accept documents signed by DocuSign or by another commercially reasonable e-signature program. Claimants' law firms should coordinate submission of documents signed by DocuSign or by another commercially reasonable e-signature program with Verus Claims Services.

These Policies extend but do not negate the Policies in effect from April 1, 2020 to August 3, 2020. The Trust may change these Policies at any time and in its sole and absolute discretion.
